Students who participate in the school-year portion of Health Horizons qualify for a paid summer work experience in the health-care field.

Attend Saturday Career Camps

Three Career Camps will be held at The Cleveland Clinic and other sites. At each Career Camp, you take part in hands-on activities, health-care simulations, and discussions with professionals. These activities are connected to your career goals.

Receive coaching and mentoring

A Y.O.U. Career Coach provides individual mentoring and connects you to comprehensive services. A Y.O.U. Employment Specialist works with you and with employers.

Receive tutoring

OGT tutoring and computer tutoring are included on a regular basis. This will help you succeed academically and will help build a foundation for future success.



.Learn about options for college

The Urban League provides college-prep workshops, college tours, and access to A.C.E.S. scholars program.

Develop workplace skills

You'll learn how to prepare a resume and how to interview successfully in the health-care field. A Mock Interview will prepare you for the real thing!

To keep the job, you'll learn teamwork skills, communication skills, and leadership skills.

Develop leadership skills

Activities include life skills, especially how to avoid alcohol and drugs and how to develop leadership skills.

Earn income and work experience in a health-focused internship

After completing Health Horizon requirements during the 2008-09 school year, you will have a paid job or internship in summer 2009.

Juniors and seniors are eligible for an 8-week summer internship at a Cleveland Clinic site. Freshmen and sophomores will be eligible for jobs at hospitals or other health-related work-sites.
