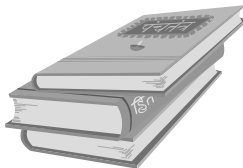

What is JOG?

JOG is an in-school program of Youth Opportunities Unlimited (Y.O.U), offered as an elective credit. It meets 1 period daily. The class is taught by a Career Coach who works with students in the class and individually.

JOG is taught by a Career Coach, who is 100% devoted to the success of every student.

Our first goal is to help you graduate.

JOG students receive both group and individual academic support. We'll help you build the skills that will help you succeed,

JOG provides job placement!

A Y.O.U. Employment Specialist works with the Career Coach and JOG students to help prepare for part-time or summer job success, or, after high school, a full-time entry level job.

Y.O.U.'s database of employers matches student's interests and dreams with job openings.



Earn credit

Participating students earn 1 elective credit per year.

Receive personal attention

Each student has a Y.O.U Career Coach and an Employment Specialist, and receives individualized attention to build skills and abilities.
